### Procedure to sign up for continuing education unit

# STEP 1

Visit the official web page of AECA at www.aecacert.com to access the online renewal application.

# STEP 2

Fill and submit the online renewal application and pay \$50/certification that you wish to renew. Multiple certifications can be renewed on the same online renewal application.

# STEP 3

On submitting the online renewal form an email with details on how to complete your continuing education will be emailed to you, read the instruction and follow the link provided.

## STEP 4

The email will have links to CEUs. You are required to click on the link and visit the individual CEU page to attend and submit the complete CEUs.

## STEP 5

After you have successfully completed and submitted your requried number of CEUs, the candidate will be certified for one more year.

### STEP 6

A new certification packet is processed and mailed within 15-20 business days starting from the date you submitted your last CEUs.

# **FAQ**

Why am I attending continuing education units (C.E.U.s)?

It is a standard procedure to renew certifications of AECA, therefore all candidate are required to attend CEUs in order to renwal their certifications.

#### o Evaluation:

• At the end of the continuing education units, the candidates will need to attempt a continuing education exam.

#### Rationale:

- To ensure that the candidate is proficient with the knowledge.
- To ensure that the candidate in covering the majority of the content areas of the certification.

All these steps are taken to ensure that the candidate stays current with the knowledge.

When should a candidate apply for recertification?
 Recommended 60 days before expiration.

"KNOWLEDGE FADE DUE TO NON-USE"

#### What is skill maintenance?

Skill maintenance is the process of preventing skills from deteriorating below an acceptable performance level.

#### **Retention interval**

It is widely accepted that the longer the period of non-use the greater the probability of decay (Annett, (1979); Farr, (1987); Gaurlin & Sitterly, (1972); Hurlock & Montague, (1982); Naylor & Briggs, (1961); Prophet (1976) cited in Arthur et al. (1998)).

#### Skill re-acquisition

Skill re-acquisition is the concept relating to the re-training of a skill that has deteriorated below an acceptable criterion. The greater the skill loss, the greater the effort required to bring the individual up to proficiency. Summers et al. state that the considerations for skill re-acquisition include: the nature, timing, amount, and frequency of training.


- The nature of the training may simply be to remind the individual of the information.
- The timing is concerned with the operational requirement and the availability of the necessary facilities.
- The amount and frequency of training are related to the level of skill loss, task difficulty, the level of skill proficiency required and the purpose for the training.
